

Sterling Capitol Profile

Capitol Park, Goole, is one of five business parks developed in Yorkshire by property company Sterling Capitol.

Sterling Capitol was formed in May 1991 and has developed an excellent reputation as one of the most accomplished and effective property development companies in the north of England.

Apart from 310-acre mixed-use development at Capitol Park, Goole, Sterling Capitol has developed the £100 million, 55-acre Capitol Park at Morley, South Leeds J28 M62; the 72-acre Capitol Park at Thorne, near Doncaster J6 M18 and the £20 million Capitol Park at Normanton near Wakefield J31 M62. Sterling Capitol is also currently developing the new 36-acre strategic gateway site adjacent to J37 M1 at Dodworth near Barnsley.
